#### Safe Environment

At the Y, we employ suitably qualified staff to supervise, care for, and educate children and young people across all of our programs and services. We strive always, to act in the best interests of children and young people who are entrusted to our care and take all reasonable steps to ensure their safety.

Above all, we are committed to providing an environment where everyone is protected from any form of abuse and harm or inappropriate behaviour. At the Y we believe in the power of inspired children and young people. For children and young people to be inspired, we know they need to feel safe and be safe.

At the Y Queensland, our mission is to provide opportunities for all people to grow in mind, body, and spirit, in a safe environment. The Y Queensland is committed to the safety and well-being of all children and young people accessing its programs and services.

The Y Queensland supports the rights of the child and will deliver a child safe environment at all times. The Y Queensland also supports the rights and wellbeing of our Y People and encourages their active participation in building and maintaining a safe environment for children and young people.

Y People must maintain the highest standards of professional conduct in their behaviour towards children, young people, and their families.

Y Queensland has developed strong processes and procedures to help keep children and young people safe. We have clear policies, stringent employment procedures including Working with Children Checks, as well as regular staff training.

All staff complete a Safeguarding induction, are trained in our National Safe Behaviours, and must abide by the Safeguarding Code of Conduct and complete an annual refresher on Safeguarding.

Y Queensland partners with the Australian Childhood Foundation (ACF) as an Assurance agency in supporting our practice and policies on Safeguarding.

#### **Recruitment Practices**

We require staff and volunteers to undergo an extensive screening process prior to appointment. Successful applicants must:

- Maintain a current Working with Children Check.
- Complete a face-to-face interview that includes Safeguarding questions
- · Pass two reference checks
- Complete the Y's Feel Safe, Be Safe Annual Safeguarding Training, along with induction training on the Y's Safeguarding Policy and Procedures, including agreement to the Y Qld's Safeguarding Code of Conduct.




#### Safeguarding Framework
