

The Journey to Employment for Year 11

Year 11 students are enrolled in two or three of the QCAA Applied subjects from our Essentials Learning Suite or the Short Courses in Literacy and Numeracy from the Vocational Learning Suite. All students complete the school Wellness curriculum – Body, Mind and Spirit (BMS).
